I thought that members of Carolina Jaguar Club might want to know of the recent passing of George Robinson, a prominent Jaguar mechanic located in Surfside Beach, South Carolina. Many Jaguar owners in the area were assisted by George including myself. Below is a remembrance that I posted in our Grand Strand British Car Club newsletter.

In Memoriam: Jaguar George

"Jaguar George" Robinson, born Aug. 30, 1958, passed away on Jan. 16, 2018, at MUSC in Charleston, S.C., due to influenza. George was 59 years of age. Although not a member of GSBCC, George was well known to several club members as the owner of Exotic Auto in Surfside Beach and as an expert extraordinaire in the maintenance of Jaguars. He was formerly the owner of Jaguar Specialists in Fairless Hills, PA.

Services were held at Grand Strand Funeral Home in Surfside Beach, S.C., on Jan. 27.

As a post script:

George's widow Annie Robinson (tel. 843-516-1206) has reached out to our GSBCC members to let them know that she is trying to liquidate his shop inventory which includes many parts and project cars. George was basically a one-man shop with others assisting has he needed them, so an unfortunate resource loss in our area. This might be a great opportunity for someone in need of parts.

We were happy to run into fellow CJC member Lawrence Baxter at the auction and later at the show on Saturday...."The three Amigos."




We plan on doing this again next year. If you love cars and people watching, this concours should be on your bucket list. There would be more but I am out of space.

Our current CJC was officially formed and affiliated with JCNA in 1992. In the Spring of 1993, CJC members Dave Eckrote and Jack Vaughn went to Seattle to participate in the first AGM attended by our newly formed club. Apparently one of the JCNA officials made a comment to Dave to the effect of "Why don't you guys host the AGM next year?" So...what could possibly go wrong? CJC is less than a year old and the members have pretty much zero experience regarding the AGM. However, Dave, who was pretty much fearless about this kind of stuff, said "Sounds like fun" and agreed to do it.

The 1994 AGM was hosted by CJC in Charlotte in the Spring of 1994 to rave reviews and generated tall tales for years to come. It was accomplished by a club that had 36 members at that time. Dave's thank you list will remind some of us who have been around a while of some of the stalwart members who have helped make the club go for many years: Jack and Fontella Vaughn, Harley Davidson, Bob Wasson, Ron and Karen Bennett, Mike Rhyne, Von and Sally Patterson, Norm and Patti Parrish, and Leland Kew.

Margaret and I joined CJC in 1997 and tales still abounded of how a small group hosted the AGM on the fly in '94. Dave was club president in '98 and '99 and I served as vice president so I picked up a lot of the AGM stories (some over Glen Farclas and cigars in the hotel bar in London on our 1999 England trip).

I served as President in '00 and Dave, who remained the prime mover of much of our club activities at that time, said "Let's host the AGM again. It'll be fun." I told Dave that Margaret and I would be the co-chairs if he would agree to serve as President and be the face of CJC during the event if we hosted it. I didn't want to keep all the fun to myself.

In the Spring of 2002, Margaret and I travelled to Vancouver to make our presentation to the 2002 AGM and it was approved at that meeting that CJC would host the AGM in Charlotte in 2003.

I have a friend who says "the hard part is the fun part." If so, we had a lot of fun planning for the AGM. We had to settle on a venue, plan the arrangements for the JCNA board meeting and the general meeting, organize educational workshops (club management, wire wheel maintenance), provide optional entertainment (driving classes



The 2003 AGM was only possible with the help of many club members. We reported to the club afterward that at least 55 members of CJC were involved either on site in Charlotte or before or after the meeting itself. Then JCNA President Gary Hagopian said he "had been to every AGM since 1991 and never been to a better one."



The fact that so many members who participated in the 2003 AGM are still active members is testimony to the longevity and vitality of CJC. One of the positives of tackling such a major project is it requires participation of a large part of the group and forms bonds of shared experience among the members. Should we consider another JCNA AGM by CJC in CLT?
















