Jaguars On Display At CJC Concours, Little Switzerland, NC

Folks, we are in the home stretch toward our 2018 CJC HEAD FOR THE MOUNTAINS Concours, being held from July 12 to July 14! The days are longer, the (grand)kids are out of school, and we're ready for some cooler weather!

As of this writing, we have 46 attendees, and 16 judged vehicles! We know you are coming because you booked a room so get your registrations in. Particulars are below:

REGISTRATION:

We are accepting checks as payment, and as always, payment must be made prior to joining in the fun and/or entering your car for judging. **PLEASE POST-MARK YOUR ENTRIES BY JUNE 22!**

Costs to the club have increased, so you will notice the increases in the registration.

Your personal registration costs have been the same price for over 5 years. They have been raised to help cover the administrative supplies used for the event.

It was previously understood the meal and the drink costs included taxes and gratuity, but we were informed they did not. The Inn has now included taxes and gratuity in the meal and drink ticket costs.

Drink tickets can only be used at the Patio Bar cocktail hour that precedes the Friday and Saturday night dinners. They are good for one beer, one wine, or one simple cocktail. You will receive one drink ticket per person with each registration. You may pre-purchase additional drink tickets on your registration for \$7 each (slightly less than our cost from the Inn).

FRIDAY DRIVE EVENT:

Jerry Ellison has graciously agreed to provide our drive destination again this year. Don Koepnick will lead the group via Scenic Byways to Old Fort, NC, where you will have the chance to visit and tour the Mountain Gateway Museum.

FRIDAY EVENING ENTERTAINMENT:

The CONCOURS Itself – Saturday, July 14:

As in past years, the plan is to park the Judged cars on the grass behind the Restaurant, and the Display cars behind the Inn. Our Field Team will begin escorting cars to their appointed positions on Saturday at 08:00am. There will be no parking on the field prior to Saturday 8am. And all cars must be escorted – both Judged and Display.

Our Concours has become very popular to surrounding car clubs and enthusiasts. Because we are dedicated to the safety of our people, the Inn's property, and our vehicles, and based upon our experiences over the past 4 years, we will be limiting the number of Judged vehicles on the grass field to 30 (same as last year), and the Display vehicles on the grass field to 10. Of course, using the grass area is always subject to weather and at the Inn's discretion.

Luckily, this does not limit the number of vehicles to be judged or displayed!

Overflow (or inclement weather) parking for Judged vehicles will be in the parking lot nearest the tennis court; overflow (or inclement weather) parking for Display vehicles will be in the parking lot nearest Geneva Hall.

Report: Jaguar plans to relaunch XK sports car alongside redesigned F-Type

For the last two years, the F-Pace and more recently released E-Pace have been the perennial cash cows for Jaguar. In 2017 alone, the F-Pace SUV accounted for twofifths of all the brand's sales, and has sold more examples than any vehicle in Jaguar's 70-year history.

That doesn't mean Jaguar has abandoned its sports car roots, as a recent report from AutoCar indicates.

When talking to Hanno Kirner, the head of product strategy at Jaguar Land Rover, the British automotive site found out that the F-Type will serve as the catalyst for an entire portfolio of sports cars.

The current F-Type, which is based heavily on the discontinued XK platform, is slated for an overhaul in 2019. The redesigned F-Type will be underpinned by a flexible platform able to accommodate sports cars of various sizes, seating arrangements and powertrains. These sentiments mirror those of Ian Callum, the head of design at Jaguar. Callum, the mastermind behind the F-Type sports car, hinted at the return of the XK sports car. According to AutoCar, a design concept for an XK replacement was in development, but was axed. Now, it appears as though Jaguar gave Callum and his design team the green light to restart the project, which won't be launched until at least 2021.

At launch, the next-gen F-Type and subsequent XK will be powered by Jaguar Land Rover's Ingenium 2.0-liter turbo 4-cylinder engine paired to an inline-six, altogether producing 295 horsepower. Other engine options will replace the current crop of V6s, as Jaguar Land Rover look to shed the remaining residue of its former Ford ownership.

In January, AutoCar reported that Jaguar's flagship XJ sedan may go all-electric by year's end, thanks to the EV powertrain found in the I-Pace crossover. The XJ will become more closely aligned with high-performance EV sedans such as the Tesla Model S P100D and upcoming Porsche Mission E. That EV XJ is being co-developed alongside an off-road-ready EV wagon similar to the Audi A4 Allroad and Volvo V90 Cross Country.




